## Welcome to Vanuatu... The Eternal Land

Vanuatu is an archipelago of 83 islands in the South Pacific. The native Melanesian people of Vanuatu call themselves ni-Vanuatu, people of the eternal land. Their concept of wealth was traditionally based on how much one could give away. They are friendly and loving people, devoted to their families and villages.

In the late 19th century, Vanuatu was claimed jointly by France and Britain. Half of Vanuatu's males were sent to Australia as indentured slaves. Due to the introduction of European diseases into the islands, the population of native people was reduced to 45,000 by 1935.

A little more than twenty-five years ago Vanuatu was returned to the people, who established their own independent republic. Their elected government works in conjunction with a Council of Chiefs that advises the government on all matters related to ni-Vanuatu culture and traditions. The population is thriving once again and they welcome visitors from around the world to experience the wonders of their land.



In 2006 the New Economics Foundation and Friends of the Earth, rated Vanuatu as the happiest place on earth due to its innovative tax structures and strong support for sustainable social, cultural, economic and agricultural development. Yet, many challenges remain for the ni-Vanuatu to become the beneficiaries of all their eternal land has to offer. Several internationally-owned hotels and resorts operate in Vanuatu, which depends on tourism as a significant part of its economy. The people are hindered in developing their own native-owned tourism enterprises due to the long distances between the islands and from main markets, and lack of essential services.

### *The Needs of the People*

Though central electrical systems exist on the island of Efate and in some towns and villages, the majority of Vanuatu's people live in remote areas with no electricity. Many of these rural ni-Vanuatu have a vision of creating a more sustainable future for their children and the earth. These native people believe that, as their country develops, it will be important to establish systems that will give the people a future free from dependency on expensive, non-renewable resources, chemical agriculture, and environmental abuse and neglect.

### *Espiritu Santo ~*

Espiritu Santo, the largest of Vanuatu's islands, lies one hour north by air from the provincial capital of Port Vila on the island of Efate. Santo is home to ancient rainforests, exotic birds, pristine beaches, organic farms, and the highest mountains in Vanuatu. Ecological preservation and conservation are strong values on Santo, where a vast wilderness area has become the first National Park in Vanuatu, and international organic trade and eco-adventure markets are being developed. The island has recently become more accessible with the addition of an international airport in the capital of Luganville, and tourism is on the rise.

### *Lonnoc Village and the Voccor Family Business*

Daniel Voccor and his family live in a traditional ni-Vanuatu village in northern Santo. They offer accommodation at Lonnoc Beach Bungalows on a beautiful white sand beach. The family built and maintains these traditional bungalows, and their business offers great value and service to their guests in a stunning natural environment. They also have a restaurant on site for guests and visitors alike. Their enterprise is ideally located for adventure travel, maritime recreation, indigenous cultural activities, and eco-tourism.



### *Power for the people... power from the sun*

Lonnoc Village presently relies on diesel generators that primarily power refrigerators in homes and the restaurant. Daniel would like to install solar systems to take advantage of the island's prolific sunshine, reduce transportation and fuel costs, and avoid using non-renewable energy resources on the island. Solar equipment, installation and expert consultation are beyond the present means of the Voccor family, and no assistance is available through the government or any existing aid programs.
